

PCIT INCLUSION CRITERIA

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BEHAVIORS

- ★ The child is exhibiting difficult to manage behaviors according to the referring party, such as:
 - **Aggression:** hitting, kicking, biting, scratching
 - **Tantrums/Outbursts:** whining, crying, dropping
 - **Noncompliance:** not listening, having trouble waiting, not following directions
 - **Other:** Talking back, swearing, easily distracted, problems with siblings, kicked out of daycare/school

LANGUAGE

- ★ Currently, offered to patients and families fluent in **English**

LIVING ARRANGEMENT

- ★ The child lives with the caregiver (legal guardian) who will participate in PCIT at the start of treatment

AGE

- ★ The child is 2.5-7 years*

And

Language development of at least a ~2.5 year-old

*Can be modified for 8-10 years

AVAILABILITY

- ★ PCIT clinicians are available from 8:30am-5:00pm on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays

PARENTAL ENGAGEMENT

- ★ **Parents are agents of change**
- ★ PCIT will require ongoing engagement
 - PCIT 1 hour weekly sessions for 15-20+ weeks
 - or PC-CARE for 1 hour weekly sessions for 8 weeks
